Hygiene Kits Items:

The following list contains suggested items for a Hygiene Kit. You can creatively package the items however you'd like. Inspirational notes within the kits are welcomed, but not required.

- Travel size Shampoo & Conditioner
- Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Dental floss
- Fold-up hair brush or comb
- Razor
- Small first aid kit
- Travel-size sewing kit (minimum
- thread and needle)
- Deodorant
- Travel soap or body wash
- Hand sanitizer
- Lotion

- Sunscreen lotion
- Lip balm (i.e. chapstick) Tampons and sanitary pads
- New socks
- Rain poncho
- Small pack of tissues
- Snack or granola bar
- Bottled water

Unnecessary items:

- Toilet paper
- Mouthwash
