- All volunteers must be at least 13 years old to volunteer (13 with a chaperone, 16 to volunteer without)
- Please wear closed toed shoes and long pants for your safety and protection
- All volunteers must read and acknowledge a USHS liability waiver

Group Capacity:

- At our Family Center, we can accommodate up to 8 volunteers
- At our Adult Center, we can accommodate up to 10 volunteers.
